- Can you tell me about your career path and where you see yourself in a few years?
- What did you study in college and what did you do to prepare for professional school?
- What do you wish you had known before entering this field?
- · How does this job affect your personal life?

Professional development

- When selecting a professional program, what did you look for?
- Are there things you wish you had known or investigated when selecting a professional program?
- Would it be beneficial for me to talk with other people?
- · May I use your name in contacting these people?
- If I have questions, may I stay in contact with you?
